

(SELECTED) CAMPING REGULATIONS AND ETIQUETTE

Each campsite includes a gravel pad, picnic table and fire pit. All other areas, including the riverbank, grassed areas between sites, and the road are considered common areas available to all park users.

- 1 Campsites are available on a first-come, first-served basis and cannot be reserved or held.
- 2 Camping is allowed only in designated campsites. Restrict your camp to the gravel portion of your site.
- 3 Your RV or tent must be parked or pitched at your campsite by park closing time and must be occupied overnight.
- 4 Only registered parties may occupy a campsite overnight.
- 5 Two parties may share a campsite, but each must register separately and pay the camping fee.
- 6 Up to two vehicles –trailers included– are allowed at your campsite at any time. For example, two vehicles means two cars, one car plus an RV, an RV with a trailer, or two RV's. Vehicles must be parked on the flat, gravel portion of the site.
- 7 Up to two tents are allowed per campsite. Tents must be set up on the gravel area of the site.
- 8 Visitors to your campsite must leave by the posted park closing time. Visitors must park in the day-use parking lot.
- 9 Please respect the tranquility of the park and privacy of your fellow visitors. Generators must be well muffled. Playing loud music is not permitted. 'Quiet time' is from 11 pm to 6 am.
- 10 Please make sure you keep your campsite clean. Do not leave containers of food or coolers in the open, unattended.

Check out time is 11 am.
