




Food Hubs - meeting needs/filling gaps



 an exciting, emerging trend in local and regional food systems development – over 170 in US and Canada - systems approach is critical



 different shapes and sizes but building infrastructure for bringing farmers (supply) and buyers/consumers (demand) together

Year-round farmers market



 Storage, aggregation, distribution to match small-medium scale growers with small to medium scale buyers – provide the infrastructure

 Commercial kitchen – to increase education, access, support small-scale food processors

Vancity Support for the Hub
