

Guidance – How do I register my engine?

As of January 1, 2012 all Tier 0 and Tier 1 non-road diesel engines must be registered in order to operate in the Metro Vancouver area. Completing the registration process can be done in three easy steps once you have setup your online account for the [Non-Road Diesel Engine Registration System](#).

Note: Effective January 1, 2015 all unregistered Tier 0 engines are prohibited from operating within Metro Vancouver.

Step 1: Add your Tier 1 engine(s) into the system

Your engine will be assigned a life time registration number. Registration labels will be mailed to the provided address. Remember you are not authorized to operate in Metro Vancouver until an operating period has been purchased.

Step 2: Select Operating Period(s)

Options include: Annual, Monthly, Daily, or Annual Low-Use (200 hours).

Before proceeding to payment you have the option to include additional engine operating periods to the same invoice.

Step 3: Pay for the Operating Period(s).

You can pay by credit card (Master Card or Visa) or cheque. Please note that a \$15 administrative fee will be applied to each operating period purchased. Additional engine operating periods can be purchased by completing steps 2 and 3.

From within this system you can view your registered engines, purchased operating periods, and payment history.
