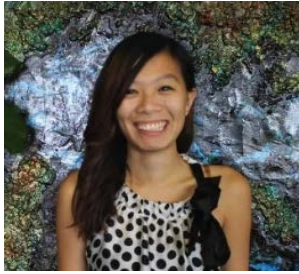


BIO – Nicole Chan
