

Park Guidelines

Regional parks are great places to enjoy the outdoors. They're also home to many plants and animals. Please help protect these special places and ensure a safe and enjoyable experience by following these guidelines.

Parking

- Park only in designated areas (not on roadways and not blocking road entrances).

Natural Park Features

- To protect park habitats, please leave vegetation, driftwood, rocks and other natural materials undisturbed.
- Do not disturb wildlife.

Designated Fire Rings

- Fires are permitted only in designated fire rings.
- Seasonal restrictions may apply. Before you arrive, check www.metrovancouver.org (search "fire rating").
- Use only bundled firewood.
- Stay with the fire at all times.
- Extinguish the fire completely before leaving (30 minutes before park closes).

Tarps, Balloons & Other Attachable Items

- Use only rope or string to attach tarps or other items to tables, shelters or trees. NO nails or staples.
- If setting up volleyball or badminton nets, only use stakes less than 30 cm (1 ft) long or you may damage sewer or water pipes.
- Balloons are bad for wildlife such as birds and turtles that can mistake them for food (and may die as a result). Also, many animals get tangled up in balloon strings. Use wildlife-friendly alternatives for decorating: paper pinwheels, crepe pompoms, reusable banners, streamers and bunting.

Special Equipment

- The use of special equipment such as generators, amplified music or PA systems may require a special permit. Contact Metro Vancouver Regional Parks before you visit by calling 604-432-6352. All permits must be presented to Regional Parks staff.

No Liquor, No Smoking, No Cannabis

- Liquor is not allowed in the park except with a special permit. For more information, contact Metro Vancouver Regional Parks at 604-432-6352.
- Smoking is not allowed in regional parks. This includes tobacco, e-cigarettes and cannabis. Most parks have designated smoking areas marked by signs that allow the use of tobacco and e-cigarettes (but not cannabis).

All permitted activities must be finished 30 minutes before the park closes.

Please leave the site clean and remove excess garbage, signs, route markers and other material. Thank you.
