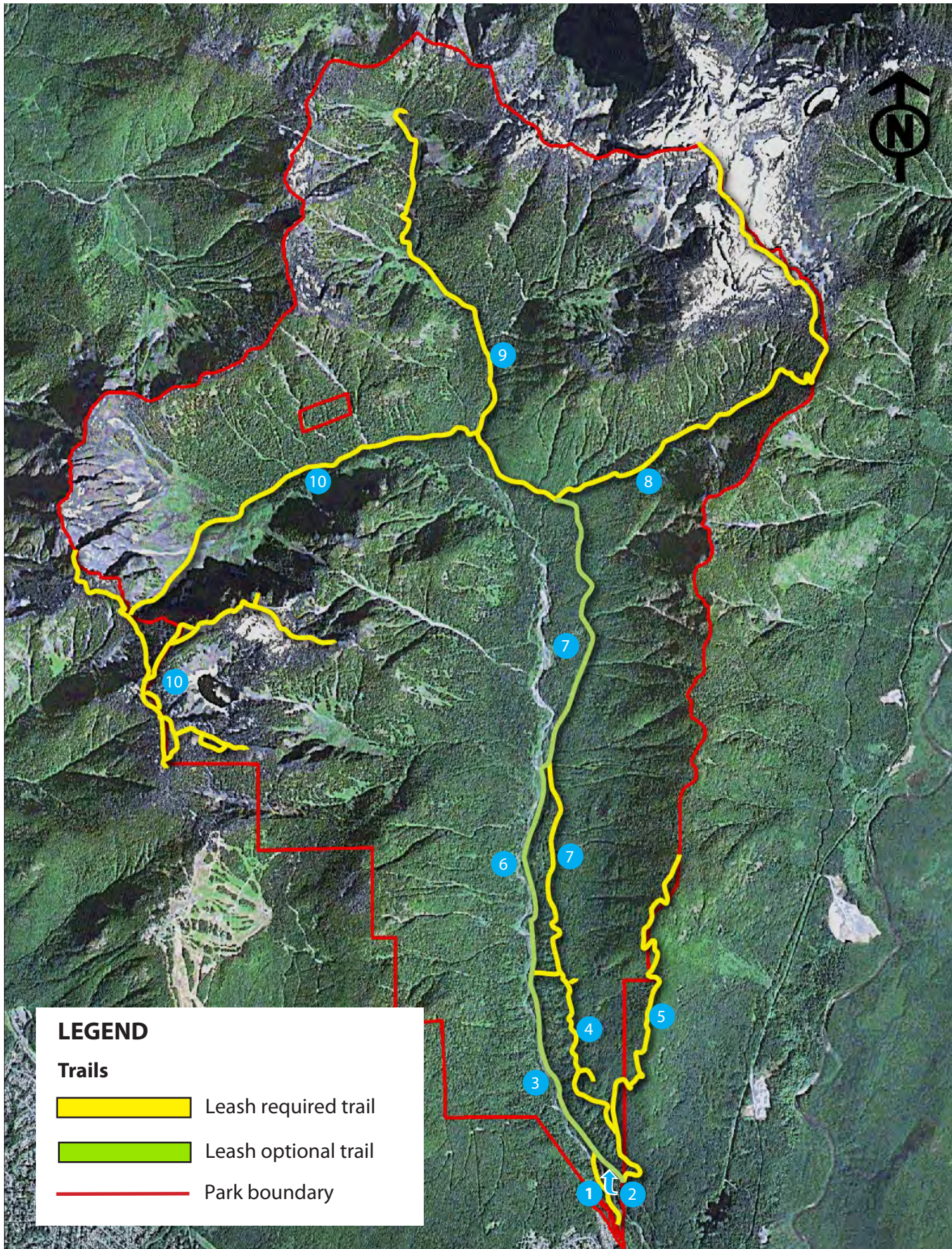


LYNN HEADWATERS REGIONAL PARK

Dog Management Plan Effective January 1, 2013



On January 1, 2013, a new dog management plan takes effect at Lynn Headwaters Regional Park.

The trails marked in green (Lower Lynn Loop, Cedars Mill Trail, the portion of Headwaters Trail north of Third Debris Chute and the connector trail between Lynn Headwaters Regional Park and the Lower Seymour Conservation Reserve) are designated as leash-optional.

Just remember, even if your dog is off-leash, it must still be under your control.

All other trails in the park are designated as leash-required.
