
















## How many Green Bins does my apartment building need?

Metro Vancouver has estimated the number of bins needed for collecting residential food scraps and food-soiled paper, based on the number of units in the building. It assumes collection once per week, and can serve as a guide to discuss with your collection service provider.

Keep pests and odours to a minimum by ensuring your Green Bin is regularly emptied and cleaned. Make it easy for residents to participate. If recycling bins are overflowing or not clean, recyclables will likely end up in the garbage.
